

Who is eligible for My Aged Care?

My Aged Care support services may be generally available for people over 65 years of age (or Indigenous Australians aged 50+) who need extra support to continue living as well as they can.

You might be eligible if you meet certain criteria, including:

- * Having experienced a recent fall, reduced mobility or changes in your memory capacity
- * Being diagnosed with a medical condition
- * Having changes in your existing care arrangements.

Depending on your eligibility, the Australian federal government may fund your needs partially or entirely. Home Care Packages are a government funded program through which older Australians can access care services to help them live independently at home, especially for those with more complex care needs.

There are four levels of Home Care
Packages, and an individual is assessed
for their eligibility for the appropriate level,
based on their needs and capabilities.
If and when you are approved, funds are
generally administered by a Home Care
Package provider, who pays for the
services you would receive.
The first step to applying for a Home Care

Package is to determine if you are eligible.

To be approved for a Home Care
Package, you would first complete an aged
care assessment, conducted by an Aged
Care Assessment Team (ACAT)
representative, who will discuss your
current care needs and supports.

There is no reason anyone should have obstacles in their way to having a freshly cleaned home. Cherubs is here to help








We work with you and your Aged Care, DVA or NDIS plan manager or support coordinator to provide the cleaning service you require.
